#### WEATHER

Buenos Aires in central Argentina has the following low/high temperatures
October 13-22 degrees
November 16-25 degrees
December 18-25 degrees
rising to 18-28 degrees towards the end of the month.

#### **WHAT TO BRING**

Buenos Aires can be very warm, whilst your trip to Antarctica will require items for zero degrees. A good quality winter coat, hat, gloves, thick socks and thermals are a must along with sunglasses and of course a good camera.
